The Axopar 38 is designed to make boating feel effortless, regardless of a captain's level of experience. Furthermore, the Axopar 38 range is economical to own, cost-efficient to run, and simple to maintain. It's designed to be the most affordable in the market, being 20-25% lighter than competitors' boats and 25%+ cheaper than the closest competitors.

The Axopar 38 focuses on easy handling and confidence on water with new digital tools and purposeful design improvements. The dashboard layout is clean and intuitive, giving the driver everything they need at a glance. These systems are designed to enhance confidence by giving boaters the right information at the right moment — without adding complexity.



Furthermore, customers can tailor each area, from bow layout and cabin choices to wheelhouse seating arrangements, fender box options, and aft deck setups, allowing more freedom, fewer compromises, and a level of adaptability rarely seen in this size segment. 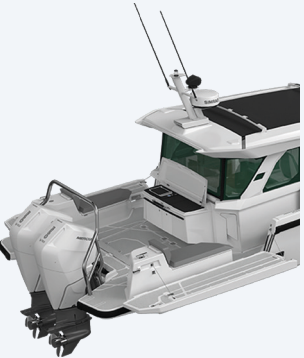

Front Cabin: Reimagined functionality of the front cabin. Combined sofa and bed solution for added usability of the front cabin. Improved headroom and standing height. Optional enclosed toilet with optional shower. Optional kitchen module with space for microwave, fridge, and coffee machine. Optional gullwing doors for connecting cabin with the outdoors.

Wheelhouse: Reimagined wheelhouse layout. Efficient use of space optimized for moving easily around. U-sofa with table for up to 6 people – additionally rotating helm seats or Mediterrana sofa with flipping backrest. Optional electric hi-lo table, convertible into a bed. Openable aft window option (manual or electrical) – connecting the wheelhouse to aft deck. Optional bar cabinet on port side.

Other highlights: Ample, smart storage spaces. Sound insulation upgrade as standard for added comfort onboard. Improved air-conditioning and lithium power bank options. Optional JPO integration to bow thruster. Optional Burnewiin gunwale mounts for aft or bow, enabling a variety of accessories with quick attachment. BRABUS trim line.

Fixed aluminum fuel tank of 830L with overflow prevention. Heavy-duty rub rail with rubber end caps in grey, also around swim platforms. Axopar 3D signature chrome logo on the hull. Bow thruster tunnel preparation in hull. Walk-around deck layout with open aft deck. Anti-skid finishing on working deck areas and deck hatches. Self-draining deck, cockpit and helm areas. All hardware, pulpits, locks, hinges, filler caps & cockpit grab rails in 316 stainless steel. 6 cleats on aft, midship and fore deck. Additional hooking points for safety harness. Fore deck pulpits. Integrated side rails. LED navigation lights on roof. Spacious anchor locker with drainage in bow. Storage compartment on foredeck with cushion. Sofa with backrest on fore deck, including harbour covers. Three electric bilge pumps with auto-function. Manual bilge pump for aft section. Trim-tabs with joystick control. Integrated swim platforms and telescopic bathing ladder. Grab rail under aft window. Integrated boarding steps / maintenance access on both sides of helm. 180-degree foldable light mast in white painted aluminium with anchor light. Twin large fender storages with insulation / cooler boxes. Aft deck with large storage compartment. Battery / electrical compartment under aft deck storage. Flagpole. Signal horn.

Front Cabin: L-shaped lounge sofa and seating. Large queen size bed with side bolsters. All upholstery in Luna Cement 1321 fabric. Roof panels in Matties M36. Window towards fore deck with an openable hatch. Mirror in forward bulkhead. Foldable shelves at bedside. Pentry module with upper and lower modules. Lower module with sink and faucet, including 5 drawers. Option for a drawer fridge. Space reservation for a microwave. Electric toilet under

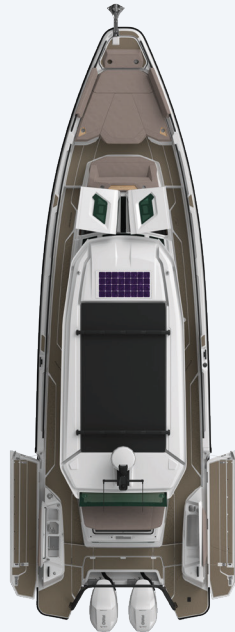
L-sofa with 70L septic tank. Main 12V fuse panel with automatic fuses. USB outlet in front cabin. Fire & CO2 alarms. LED spotlights and light strip between skylights. Carpet in grey.

Helm: Clean helm layout. Dashboard in black and console top panels in grey-green metallflake finish. Display panels in black high-gloss finish. Control switch panel in glass with illuminated push buttons. Main control panel with remote controlled battery switches. Steering wheel in leather with Axopar logo. Lockable hatch to front cabin with grab rail in leather. Sliding door to front cabin with Adventure pattern. Wireless phone charger. Document pocket on console wall. Footrest with EVA decking.

Wheelhouse: Toughened glass windscreen and side windows in light green tint. Fully enclosed cabin with extra wide and lockable sliding doors. Roof with large opening canvas roof and harbour cover. Two integrated and mechanically linked windscreen wipers. 360-degree panoramic view. Rotating front seats with flip-up bolster. Large dining area around the table including two sofas. Table with fixed leg, foldable tabletop with integrated handle in walnut. Raised floor level around dining area with storage. Foldable footrest in walnut for aft sofa, enabling entrance to the aft section. Openable sofa backrest with storage inside. Large storage behind aft sofa and inside mid-seat base. Convertible mid-seat: forward facing having the table as backrest with a soft pad or aft facing to socialize around the table. Shoebox under the portside sliding door. Storage pockets on sliding doors. Walnut grab handle in portside B-pillar. Four recessed LED downlights. Two USB outlets. Fire & CO2 alarms. Luna Cement 1321 fabric on all seats and upholstery. Roof panels in acoustic fabric Matties M36. Carpet in grey.



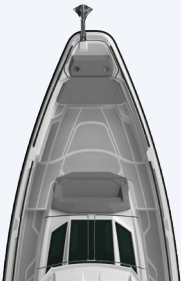
XC Cross Cabin with optional wetbar and activity platforms and gullwing doors open



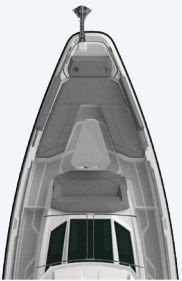
XC Cross Cabin with optional aft cabin and activity platforms and gullwing doors open, Mediterrana Edition

LAYOUT ALTERNATIVES FOR BOW

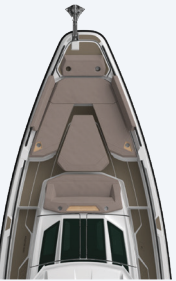

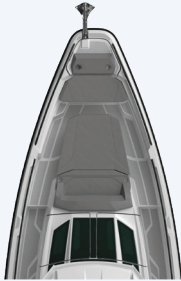
XC Cross Cabin with forward facing sofa + bow seat



XC Cross Cabin with optional u-sofa package, table

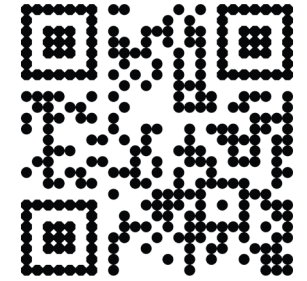


XC Cross Cabin with optional u-sofa package, sunbed fill, Mediterrana Edition
